What is the Lifeguard Program?

- A support system for students.
- A time to build relationships
- *Sophomores, Juniors, & Seniors selected a "lifeguard"—a teacher you trust and an advocate for you---last year.
- Freshmen will select a Lifeguard in September after you get to know your new teachers.

What is the Lifeguard Program?

What Lifeguard is:

- Having a trusted adult for attendance, behavior, coursework, & LIFE issues
- A time to **build relationships** long-term interactions w/ individual students
- Character Education
- A time to develop learning, thinking, and life skills

What Lifeguard is NOT:

- Homeroom time
- Homework time
- A study hall/free period
- A replacement for the guidance office



How Lifeguard Works:

- Students will select a Lifeguard (teacher/staff member)
- You will be placed in one of your top 3 preferences
- Lifeguard will meet once a month starting in September

How Lifeguard Works:

- A "Lifeguard" is an ADVOCATE—a trusted adult who can mentor and help students develop skills for learning, thinking, and life skills
- Each month will have a specific schoolwide focus and activity.
- THIS YEAR, YOU WILL BE PLACED IN A "DEN."
 This will include an exciting school-wide competition via social media and other activities.
