

## SOS Kick-Off

- Kids sit down with their homeroom (intermediate will follow the intermediate seating chart-but K-3 students will be seated as they enter because only two grade levels will be in the gym at a time.)
- Kristen will introduce SOS Kick-Off-Students of Success
- Alexa will lead the the groups through an advocacy introduction game: Stand Up If.....  
Stand up if your favorite food is pizza.  
Stand up if your favorite day of the week is Saturday.  
Stand up if you've ever needed a grown up to talk to for any reason.  
Stand up if you've ever had a bad day.
- Alexa will introduce the goal of SOS- to have an adult to go to when you need someone.
- Kristen will finish with explaining SOS days. They will occur once a month, but your assigned SOS adult is here for you always.
- Kristen will ask teachers for each SOS group to come down to the gym floor.

- Choose a meeting spot for your group. This needs to be the same place each month. If you are a homeroom teacher, you will need to use your classroom. Please let Alexa and Mrs. Manning know where your group will be meeting as soon as possible.
- Alexa will send an agenda with activities you can do with your SOS group each month. You may use them if you like, but you can also create your own activities if you wish.
- Teresa D, Toshia, Jackie F, Joy, Lancaster, Williams, Rhonda will be placed with their students, but will also serve as an advocate for a set of students.
