INTRODUCTION

EXPECTATIONS/CONSEQUENCES

The expectation for all who attend any event or field trip away from Simons Middle School is to follow all school rules and behave in a respectful and dignified manner. For students who break major rules or engage in violent, lewd, destructive, illegal, or socially inappropriate behavior, their parent/guardian will be called immediately and may be asked to come get the student.

Examples include (not limited to):

- Curfew violations (out of room or in another room)
- Rude or disrespectful behavior
- Destruction or defacing of property
- Violence towards staff, students, or others
- Drug, alcohol, or tobacco possession or use
- Possession or use of weapons

Additional consequences, out of school suspension, ISAE assignments, etc. will result upon returning to school as deemed appropriate by school administration.

AGREEMENT

The student, the parent/guardian, and the field trip sponsor will sign the Overnight Field Trip Agreement prior to the field trip.


