STATEMENT

A. Introduction

Field trips are important and engaging activities for students to extend their learning and experience connections to the real world beyond the school. Attending an overnight field trip as an SMS student is considered a privilege. It is important to remember that on each overnight/out of town trip, students represent not only Simons Middle School, but also their families and our community.

B. Expectations/Consequences

Therefore, it is the expectation for all who attend to follow all school rules and behave in a respectful and dignified manner. For students who break major rules or engage in violent, lewd, destructive, illegal, or socially inappropriate behavior, their parent/guardian will be called immediately and may be asked to come get the student. Examples include (but not limited to):

- Curfew violations (out of room or in another room)
- Rude or disrespectful behavior toward others
- Destruction or defacing property
- Violence toward staff, student, or other individual
- Drug, alcohol, or tobacco possession or use
- Weapons

Additional consequences, out of school suspension and level changes (level 1), will result upon the return to school, as deemed appropriate by school administration.

C. Agreement

The student, the parent, and the field trip sponsor will sign the Overnight Field Trip Agreement prior to the field trip.
